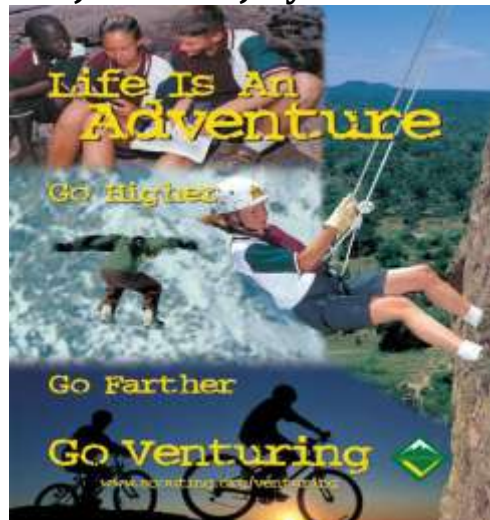




Northeast Illinois Council Venturing / Kodiak Camp Program June 26 - July 3 2010



Join us for a leadership course that will allow participants to experience outdoor adventure opportunities in Northern Wisconsin. The course will be based at Ma-Ka-Ja Wan Scout Camp in Antigo WI, with adventure opportunities in several northern Wisconsin venues.

As a part of the Kodiak we are providing up to 24 youth the opportunity to:

- Backpack in the Porcupine Mountains or Canoe Flambeau Flowage.
- Participate in team building activities.
- Participate in shooting sports activities.
- Learn valuable leadership skills
- Learn new skills that will fulfill requirements toward the Ranger and Outdoor Bronze Award.
- Have fun.



Kodiak is a leadership course taught in the Venturing program. First piloted in 2000-

2002, the course was designed to be done in an exciting and challenging atmosphere while backpacking in the Rocky Mountains, rafting the Yukon River in Alaska, on a trip to New York City, or like we are doing in our local area using the exciting resources we have available.

Kodiak is a challenging trek and at the same time a simple and fun leadership course. Rather than just talking about leadership, Venturing through the new Kodiak course, teaches useable, relevant leadership skills that every

teen can use. We use a challenging outdoor trek to use nature as a classroom. Venturing teams of 8 youth are taught 5 leadership commissions over the course of a week by two instructors. We use a hands-on learning approach with very short presentations and constant reinforcement.

Location: Ma-Ka-Ja-Wan Scout Camp

Age: 14 by June 5, 2010 Kodiak will be limited to 24 participants. Participants will be divided into 3 groups of 8 at camp. Registration begins March 15, 2010 with a \$50 non refundable deposit. Remaining fees are due June 15th, 2010. **If there are not enough participants on June 15th the event will be cancelled and refunds made.** A BSA Class III Physical is required.
